<b>Hat</b>

<b>Bag</b>

<b>Library</b>	
Compulsory waterproof library bag Children will not be allowed to borrow unless they have a school library bag	
<b>Hair</b>	
Hair must be clean, neatly groomed. Shoulder length and longer hair must be tied up with school coloured ribbons, headband or hair band. Hair should be in its natural colour, free from colours, rinses, streaks and tints. Hair should be neat and tidy with no extreme hair styles, including but not limited to tracks and undercuts. Boys' hair should be kept away from the face and no shorter than blade2.	
<b>Jewellery</b>	
For safety, students with single pierced ears should wear plain gold or silver studs rather than sleepers and only one earring in each ear. The only jewellery items permitted beyond earrings are watches. Smart watches which can access the internet are to be avoided. If students wear a smart watch they are not permitted to communicate to anyone, including parents during school hours.
